OUT OF AGE POLICY- Policy Document No 5

The North Hobart Junior Football Club believes that young people should play football with others of their own age.

It is the policy of the Club that players must seek registration in the team which is appropriate to their age.

For reasons of equity, safety and personal development the Club insists that players participate in the correct team.

It is only in exceptional circumstances where a compelling case is put by the player's guardian / parents that the Club may permit a person to play up one year only.

In making its decision, the Club will have regard for the skills and physical development of an individual; the number of players in the teams involved and whether or not the person has previously played at the higher level.

Any decision by the Club to permit a person to play out of age is for that year only; the Club may not give approval in circumstances where the viability of a team may be compromised.

Where approval for a person to play out of age is sought, parents / guardians will be required to sign a document acknowledging their consent.
