

LIFE MEMBERSHIP - Policy Document N° 6

Life membership is stated in Section 6 of the Constitution (Rules) of the Club adopted 15 April 2003 as follows:

6. LIFE MEMBERSHIP

(i) Members who have completed 5 years minimum meritorious service may be considered for Life Membership. For the purpose of this section, meritorious service means service in an official capacity and involvement in Club activities, Observance of Club values and policies and support for the work of the Club Committee. The contribution to the Club needs to have been outstanding and constant throughout the prescribed period.

(ii) Recommendation for Life Membership shall be made by the Committee at an Annual General Meeting and endorsed by three-quarters of the members present.

(iii) Life Members shall have continuous voting rights and attendance rights for all meetings conducted by the Club.

The rules of the Club state that to be considered for life membership, a member must have completed 5 years minimum meritorious service.

A member can be an Ordinary member such as a parent or guardian of a player, or an Associate member such as a club official who is recognised by the Committee.

‘Meritorious Service’ is defined as

“Service in an official capacity and involvement in club activities, observance of club rules and policies, and support for the work of the Club Committee.

The contribution to the life of the club needs to have been outstanding and constant throughout the prescribed period.”
