Penalty for playing unequal numbers shall be loss of 4 premiership points / forfeit of game; Fine \$500.00

Please note that interchange players must be marked with an asterisk (*) on the official team sheet.

Captain to be marked on team sheet as (c)

Teams wishing a counting of players during game AFL Law 5.5 shall apply.

Page 22-23 Laws of Australian Football.

The captain is to request that the field umpire count the number of players of the opposing team who are on the playing surface.

UNIFORMS

In the event of a clash of colours, all clubs are to wear their approved guernsey and shorts when designated as the HOME team and an alternate coloured guernsey and shorts, as agreed by STJFL, when designated as the AWAY team, unless otherwise determined. (Brighton club must wear alternative strip when playing against North Hobart.)

Players may not wear a glove or gloves in STJFL competition matches unless permission to do so for medical reasons is provided to the STJFL.

All Youth age teams, under (U13, U14, U15 & U16) teams when **playing away shall wear white shorts.**

(That is the second named team unless otherwise advised by the League)

Bike shorts / skins worn under shorts must be flesh coloured.

(not black, white, red, blue etc.)

Penalty for breach of this rule: Players not wearing correct playing uniform (includes skins) \$20

RUNNERS, TRAINERS, UMPIRES & TEAM OFFICIALS

- i. All team runners must wear STJFL approved Shirts. Only **ONE** runner per team
- ii. Trainers should be dressed in appropriate tops and should be instructed to return immediately to the boundary after attending players.
- iii. Club Umpires Field & Goal must wear approved STJFL apparel
Goal: Orange jacket or orange vest
Field: Orange polo shirt, orange vest or polo shirt (light green)
(light green) inexperienced or non accredited Umpire
- iv. Coaches, # Team Managers shall be appropriately identifiable as approved by the STJFL.
Appropriate club identified top, armband or name tag. Club responsibility.

Penalty for breach of rule; as per below

TIMEKEEPING

Clubs are to appoint their own Timekeepers.

It is the responsibility of the visiting team to have a time keeper sit / stand with the home club time keeper.

Time keepers are to be located in a purpose built facility or the area of the interchange.

Timekeeping Discrepancies

Where a significant discrepancy exists between the timekeepers in the timing of a quarter the timekeepers should endeavour to resolve the dispute and agree on a method of determining the length of the quarter. If an agreement cannot be reached, the Home team timekeeper's quarter timing will be adopted. If a team believes it has been unfairly treated it is entitled to lodge a protest to the **STJFL** which will take action it believes appropriate.

Timing is as follows:

U13 & U14 4 x 15 minute quarters

U15 & U16 4 x 20 minute quarters

Breaks:

¼ time 5 minutes maximum

½ time 10 minutes maximum

¾ time 5 minutes maximum

In the event of injury or undue delay time lost cannot be made up, as the start of the next scheduled game must commence on allocated time so as to allow all games at that venue that day to be kept to time.

CLUB COMPLAINTS

Clubs that may wish to lodge a complaint with the League arising from a match for incidents of concern,

Must do so by the close of business (5.00pm) on the Tuesday following the holding of the match.

This complaint must be lodged on a club letterhead and signed by either;

the President or the Football Manager with sufficient information in regards the concern.

Complaint may be lodged by email or hand delivered to the Executive Officer.

If the complaint is not of a serious nature the club should try and resolve the concern with the other club in the first instance.

Team officials smoking on ground	\$100
Failure of Team manager to obtain umpires match report after game	\$25
Failure of home team to submit match envelope on time.	\$25
First named teams responsible for entering results online & submitting match result envelope by 5.00pm Monday to AFL Tasmania office, Argyle St. North Hobart or hand delivered direct to EO.
