


Fee & Jumper Information for Parents – full details on our website
 Registration Fee:

1. **When & how much to pay** – a payment must be made to receive a jumper or to start playing games
 - you must pay the full fee or a minimum payment of \$50 for 1 child, \$80 for 2 and \$100 for 3
 - the final payment must be paid no later than the 4th roster game
 - the Auskick or U8 football pack will not be issued until fees are fully paid
2. **How to pay** – by cash, cheque, direct deposit, credit card or debit card.

 - Cheques to be made out to: North Hobart Junior Football Club or NHJFC
3. **Receipts** – a receipt is your proof of payment and must be issued by the Club.
 - the Club will only recognise that a payment has been made if you can produce a receipt, or
 - your cheque or direct deposit has been deposited in the Club account
4. **How your fee is spent** - registration fees are the Club's major source of funds for STJFL affiliation fees, umpire fees, insurance, ground hire for training and matches, footballs, training and match day equipment, end of year functions and general administration costs.
 - fees **do not** cover all expenses particularly for jumpers and equipment which are mainly met from fundraising and sponsorship

 Jumpers:

1. **Sizing, Issue & Type** – sizing will occur at training sessions/registration and be completed before player's first game
 - the Club provides a red and blue polyester jumper (Cougar, Sherwood or ID Clothing) with a number attached/sublimated
 - the jumper is issued on loan and remains the legal property of the Club
 - player & parents are responsible for jumper - the jumper is not to be lent or reissued to another person
 - U08 to U12 are issued with long sleeve jumpers *only* and U13 to U16 have a choice of long or short sleeve
2. **Identification code** - each jumper has a unique Identification Code which must not be defaced or removed
3. **Preferred numbers** - players can nominate preferred numbers but allocation will depend on availability, precedence and team allocation
4. **Changing numbers** – some jumpers have sublimated numbers which cannot be changed. For changeable numbers read below.
 - the Club does not encourage changes and will normally arrange number changes before a jumper is issued
 - if a change is permitted, numbers must be sewn on - *do not use* iron-on numbers as they destroy the polyester material
 - the Club will provide appropriate numbers on request
5. **Wear** - jumpers are issued for wear during games and Club events and are not intended for wear at training, for everyday wear and for school games without prior permission of the Club
6. **Care** - jumpers should be washed and properly maintained, and handed back in good condition allowing for normal wear and tear
 - do not remove labels or identification markings or make unauthorised alterations
 - do not bleach or use strong detergents or soakers
7. **Return** - jumper is on loan for season and must be returned after player's last game
 - if player withdraws before the end of season, the jumper *must be returned* immediately
8. **Not returned** - the replacement cost of a jumper is currently \$50 and if the jumper is not returned or is lost
 - the Club may require reimbursement of the replacement cost of a jumper
 - decline future registration with the Club or oppose future registration with other clubs in the AFL & STJFL competitions
